

**SR 6.8 I can participate in role-play by articulating clearly and demonstrating fluency.**

Here are some examples of role-play situations that can be carried out in class.

<b>Personal Identification and Emotions</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Giving / asking for advice</li><li>- Sharing information</li><li>- Making excuses</li><li>- Agreeing/disagreeing</li><li>- Describing physical appearance</li></ul>
<b>School and Education</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Pretending to be the head teacher / teacher / pupil</li><li>- Making excuses to a classmate / teacher</li><li>- Persuading a classmate / teacher</li><li>- Resolving a conflict</li></ul>
<b>Jobs</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Sitting for an interview</li><li>- Pretending to be a policeman / shop assistant / doctor</li><li>- Creating a situation on the workplace</li></ul>
<b>Food and Drink</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Ordering food</li><li>- At the supermarket</li><li>- Explaining a recipe</li></ul>
<b>Health and Fitness</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Pretending to be a nutritionist</li><li>- Pretending to be at the gym</li><li>- Holding a conversation with your friend/relative about healthy food</li></ul>
<b>Sports and Arts</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Explaining the steps of a game</li><li>- Explaining to a friend how to play / build / create</li><li>- Creating a situation at the playing field /school yard</li><li>- Holding a conversation about favourite films / plays</li><li>- Inviting someone to the cinema / theatre</li></ul>
<b>Media</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Pretending to be a news reporter and interviewing a witness</li><li>- Pretending to be a news anchor / television host</li><li>- Holding a telephone conversation</li><li>- Shopping at a computer outlet</li></ul>
<b>Places</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Asking for directions</li><li>- Pretending to be a travel agent / travel guide / tourist</li><li>- Pretending to be a tourist and asking locals for information</li><li>- Making holiday plans</li></ul>
<b>Transport</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Buying a ticket</li><li>- Creating a situation at the airport / bus station / train station</li><li>- Asking for directions</li><li>- Talking to a taxi / bus driver</li></ul>
<b>Space and Travel</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Pretending to be an astronaut</li><li>- Talking to an alien</li><li>- Interviewing an explorer from the past</li></ul>
<b>Shopping</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Buying and selling</li><li>- Pretending to be a seller at an open-air market</li><li>- Asking for directions to shops</li><li>- Convincing an adult to buy you something expensive</li><li>- Complaining about a product / service</li></ul>
<b>The Natural World and Wildlife</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Visiting the zoo / aquarium</li><li>- Pretending to be a vet</li><li>- Pretending to be on safari</li><li>- Hosting a TV show / be on a panel</li><li>- Interviewing a conservationist</li></ul>
<b>Feasts and Celebration</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Inviting someone to an occasion</li><li>- Pretending to be a party planner</li><li>- Declining / accepting an invitation to a party</li><li>- Organising an event</li></ul>
