Narrator 1: Jack and his mother were very poor. They had no money to buy food. Their neighbours were also poor and could not help.

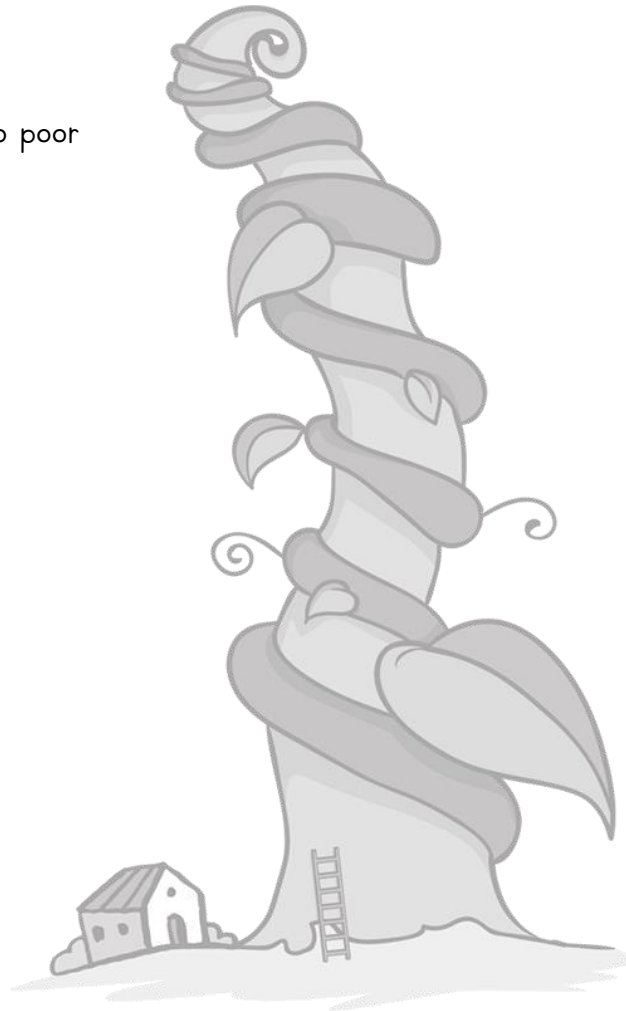
Mother: Jack, we are out of food. You must sell the cow so we can buy something to eat.
