Subject: Training for educators in preparation for 2022-2023 LO syllabi for Year 1, Year 5 and Year 9

Heads of School are hereby being informed of the dates that have been set for online training sessions in preparation for the introduction of new syllabi.

Educators teaching Year 1 and Year 2, Year 5 and Year 6 and Year 9 and Year 10 learners will receive training **during the first term** as follows:

Gozo College, Maria Regina College, St Clare College and St Nicholas College:	30 th November 2021
St Ignatius College, San Ġorġ Preca College and St Theresa College:	1 st December 2021
St Margaret College, St Benedict College and St Thomas More College:	2 nd December 2021
Church and Independent Schools:	3 rd December 2021

Training dates **for the second term** will be as follows:

Gozo College and Maria Regina College:	31 st January 2022
St Clare College:	1 st February 2022
St Nicholas College:	2 nd February 2022
St Ignatius College:	3 rd February 2022
San Ġorġ Preca College:	4 th February 2022
St Theresa College:	7 th February 2022
St Margaret College:	8 th February 2022
St Benedict College:	9 th February 2022
St Thomas More College:	14 th February 2022
Church Schools:	15 th February 2022
Independent Schools:	16 th February 2022

Training dates **for the third term** will be as follows:

Gozo College, Maria Regina College, St Clare College and St Nicholas College:	16 th May 2022
St Ignatius College, San Ġorġ Preca College and St Theresa College:	17 th May 2022
St Margaret College, St Benedict College and St Thomas More College:	18 th May 2022
Church and Independent Schools:	19 th May 2022



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It is hereby being recommended that during these full day training sessions, Heads of State Schools organise CoPE sessions for educators in KG years, Year 3 and Year 4, Year 7 and Year 8. During these days learners in KG up to Year 10 will be required to stay at home. Year 11 learners will have lessons as usual. Training on LOs for Year 11 educators is envisaged for 2022-2023.

If there are Church schools which for the first term have already set out different dates than those showing, including also dates for State schools' training, they are to first communicate them to Ms Angela Charles. Independent schools are to communicate first with Ms Sue Midolo if they also have already planned for different days for training sessions. Education Officers in the Directorate for Learning and Assessment Programmes will be informed of these dates and will try to accommodate as much as possible.
